The Youth Ambassador Council (YAC) is composed of 15–20 students from participating area high schools who are committed to serving the mission of Ronald McDonald House Charities New York Metro. Membership in the YAC requires a three-year commitment, allowing members to build long-term leadership skills and create a lasting community impact.

Selection Process

- Students will be selected based on prior leadership and service experience.
- A committee of current YAC members, the RMHC NYM Volunteer Advisor, and RMHC NYM staff will review applications.
- The selection process will include application materials and interviews to evaluate candidates.

Meeting Structure

The YAC will meet monthly from 4:30-5:30 pm except for holidays and House conflicts. In addition, each member will have opportunities to lead service activities and attend YAC signature events outside of regular meeting times.

Overview of Responsibilities

- Serve as school and community ambassadors for the Ronald McDonald House New York Metro.
- Each member will be given the opportunity to facilitate a meeting, act as secretary and take meeting minutes, and report YAC activities and updates to the Advisory Council at least one time during their commitment
- New members will have the opportunity to meet with their senior mentor before the first meeting to be welcomed to the Council.
- Attend and actively participate in all meetings.
- Attend YAC signature events and chosen service activities.
- Work towards raising funds for the House i.e. car wash, dress down days, restaurant nights, bake sale.
- Embrace becoming an ambassador and educate others about the mission and activities of RMH NYM.
